### From the Principal

#### **Works for Modular Classrooms**

Everything to date is going according to plan, the program is on time, and I have been impressed by the adaptability and patience of parents, staff and students working around closed and inaccessible gates and sometimes spur of the moment changes of direction. Traffic management and site restrictions remain in place until at this stage, the end of November, by which time everything should be back to normal.

The gate from Riva Entrance into the Early Childhood Area is closed and inaccessible at all times during this period (even when it's open) – if this gate is open, you will get a few steps inside before finding yourself fenced in!

Looking back on the year, there are causes for celebration in our attendance data, particularly in having overall regular attendance, that is, students attending 90% or more, at a rate of 88.3% - simply outstanding given the challenges in this year, including mandatory isolation and contact tracing throughout.

Another sunny spot is, of all absences, more than 90% are explained. An area of interest, and requiring improvement in 2023 is the number of absences for vacation. In 2022, the school has had an understanding approach to authorising absences for vacations, particularly given the circumstances of family separation, travel restrictions and the lack of availability of flights. This has seen the majority of such requests granted, and is a once-off arrangement. With some absences taking a school term or longer, the impact upon student progress can be profound. Again, absences have been authorised with understanding this year, and certainly compassion will endure, but, going forward, please:

- Limit if at all possible, all holidays to coincide with the school holidays;
- If it is entirely unavoidable for vacations to extend into or start before vacations, that the absolute minimum amount of school time be lost.
- Continue to advise and request authorisation from the school at <u>riva.ps@educaiton.wa.edu.au</u> for absences; and
- Understand that the school and staff do not routinely prepare or provide school work for vacations, and I have no expectation for staff to do so.

Having a Book Fair is like having a shop come to you – the most amazing, extraordinary kind of shop – a Book shop.


Cid is putting together an absolutely Pawsome Book Fair, with the theme of Paws for Books. Look out for lots of puns, playful pets, and of course oodles of books.


